Trico High School Hall of Achievement

It is the goal of the Trico CUSD # 176 to recognize individuals who have contributed significantly to our school, community, state, or country and /or have distinguished careers in business, the arts, the professions, public service, agriculture, education, or any other worthwhile field of endeavor. Emphasis will be placed on service to our society as well as personal success. Each nomination will be carefully reviewed by a committee of six anonymous individuals established by the Trico District.

Criteria for Nomination and Selection Process

- A. All candidates for the hall must be at least 10 years out of graduating high school and nominated on an official nomination form. Forms can be found on the school's website or picked up at the high school office.
- B. Nominations will open March 1, 2017 and are due in the high school office by 1:00 p.m. on September 29, 2017. All forms must be complete in order to be considered. The nominator and inductee will receive notification providing them with information about the ceremonies, should the nominee receive the required votes.
- C. Inductions will occur every other year beginning with the initial induction in February of 2016. A maximum of five individuals, may be inducted during each induction ceremony.
- D. All candidates that do not receive the required votes for induction and who are kept active will be automatically reviewed and voted on the following election year. All candidates rejected and not kept active by the committee will not be considered in following years.
- E. The selection committee will meet during the first week of October to discuss and vote on the nominees. All committee members will receive copies of all nominations to review before the final meeting in January. A committee of six persons will select which nominees will enter the Hall of Achievement. The committee will elect a chairperson, banquet/awards coordinator, secretary, nomination coordinator, media coordinator, and treasurer. The committee members will remain on the panel for ten years and may be reappointed by the Board Chairperson at the end of their tenure. The Chairperson of the committee may appoint a new member when necessary to replace an outgoing committee member. These members must remain at all times above reproach in their selections.
- F. To be voted into the Hall of Achievement the nominee is required to receive a number of votes equal to 75% of the committee members present.
- G. The committee reserves the right to remove any member who fails to maintain the Trico High School Hall of Achievement standards.
- H. Members will be inducted between a junior varsity and varsity home basketball game later in the year. A banquet honoring the inductees and their families and which shall be open to the public will be held that same weekend. The committee will pay for the inductee's meal at the banquet and a fee will be charged for all other attendees.
- I. Name(s) of nominees will not be released to the public unless selected by the committee for induction.

- J. The Chairperson is responsible for all expenditures and funding for this project will be provided by contributions from the Coca –Cola Bottling Company and ticket sales from the banquet.
- K. The committee will purchase one plaque for each inductee which will be placed in the Hall of Achievement.
- L. The committee reserves the right to deviate from the time requirement stipulation due to special circumstances. (terminal illness, etc.)
